## FLCR Twilight Swimming Time Trial Wednesday 8 February 2023

Dear Families,

The Twilight Swim Trials are for students aged 9-19 years (during 2023) who wish to trial for selection in the College team for Districts and/or SLAPS swimming carnivals (SLAPS is for junior students only). This event will also determine Age Champions.

<b>Date:</b>	Wednesday 8 February 2023
<b>Time:</b>	4.30pm-8.00pm
<b>Where:</b>	Sleemen Sports Complex
<b>Bus:</b>	A bus will be supplied for students from Beveridge Rd to Sleeman Sports Centre if required ( <b>confirm your bus booking in the registration form link below</b> ).  <b>Students will need to be collected from the Sleeman Sports Complex at the end of the time trial.</b>

To nominate for events, families/students must complete their nomination via the link below by the due date – **Wednesday 1 February 2023**.

Students aged years 10-19 wanting to represent Faith at the District Carnival in 50m events and 100m events will be selected from the results of the Twilight Time Trial and only the top two students will be selected. Junior school students will also be selected for the SLAPS Squad from these trials.

For students wanting to qualify for 200 metre events not contested at the Twilight Trials, families will need to email [active@flcr.qld.edu.au](mailto:active@flcr.qld.edu.au) with personal best times from a sanctioned Swimming Qld event, along with proof of results.

If any student is unable to participate at the Twilight Time Trial due to injury or illness but wants to be considered for a College representative team, they must provide a medical certificate as well as their PB for their events from a sanctioned Swimming Qld event. In these circumstances, students may still be considered for the College team and replace another student in that event, however this is not guaranteed.
