Students from Year 1 - 6 can borrow 1 book at a time and 2 per month in total from our [Primary ePlatform](#). Sign in is with their school username and password. Please be aware that these are shared collections of books that we do not curate from scratch, and while they have proven to be excellent collections, there can occasionally be content that may be misaligned with school or family values. Take the time to talk to your children about what they are reading.

Our local Redlands libraries <https://www.redland.qld.gov.au/info/20157/libraries> are another option for year-round borrowing and host special activities for all ages. If you've never been to one of the local branches and joined up, the holidays might be the ideal time. Our Council libraries not only have vast range of physical resources, but also provide access to digital resources for members.
