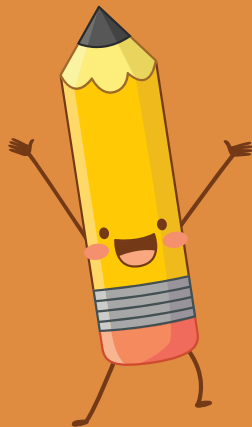

- Never in front, never behind, always beside. Service to others.
- Encourages a sense of community
- Supports a sharing over power. For example; decision making. This helps cultivate a servant leadership mindset in others.
- Integrated work ethics. This relates to the relationships that form and exist between each other and the community.
- Stewardship, listening, empathy, awareness, persuasion, and foresight are all attributes.

Together, the cohort discussed and created a list of classroom and ICT expectations which they have agreed to try and uphold;

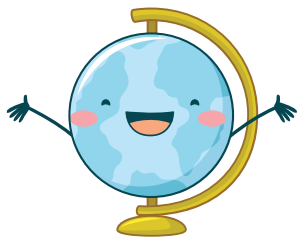
- These are displayed in the classroom and can be referred to.
- Class Examples; following the 5C's, teach not tell, be proud of your work, and role model wanted behaviours.
- Tech Examples; stay on task when using your iPad, air drop is turned off, no social media, messaging or calls during school hours, seek consent before touching someone else's iPad or when taking photos.

YEAR 6 EXPECTATIONS

- ❖ Volume down when the phone rings.
- ❖ Don't speak while others are speaking.
- ❖ Always do your best to follow the 5C's.
 - ❖ Don't run through the classrooms.
- ❖ Your iPad should be charged to at least 50%.
 - ❖ Work to the best of your ability.
- ❖ Wear the correct uniform on the right day.
- ❖ Pick your battles (think big picture).
- ❖ Bag racks should be neat and tidy.
 - ❖ Teach, not tell.
- ❖ Take pride in your work (be proud).
- ❖ Be a good role model (set good examples).
 - ❖ Follow instructions.

YEAR 6 TECHNOLOGY AGREEMENT

- ❖ Play school approved games when appropriate.
 - ❖ Stay on task when using your iPad.
- ❖ Use student safe websites (or see your teacher).
 - ❖ Air drop is turned off (unless approved).
- ❖ Don't use others peoples iPads without permission.
 - ❖ No texting or calling during school time.
- ❖ No schoolwork or students on social media.
 - ❖ No social media during school.
 - ❖ If unsure, ask your teacher.
- ❖ Always ask before taking someone's photo.
 - ❖ Leave charging iPads alone.
 - ❖ Make sure your iPad is safe.
- ❖ No playing with smart watches.
 - ❖ Hand in phones each day.

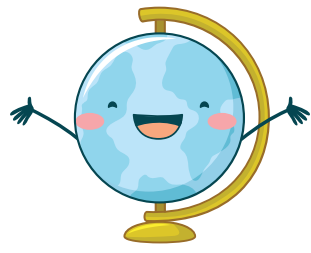

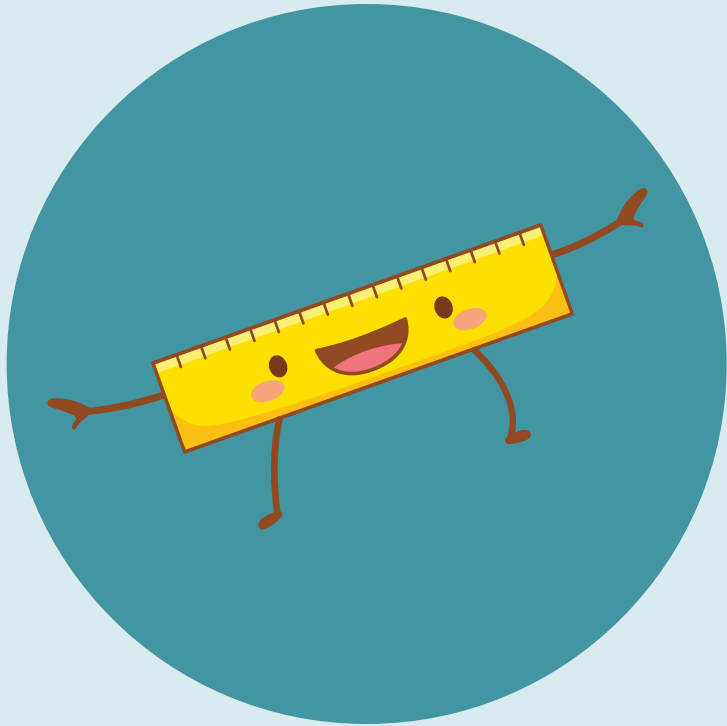

Homework

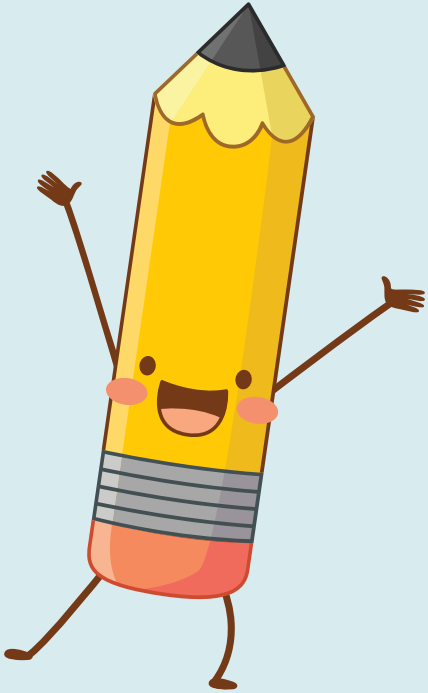


The purpose for our homework is to encourage students take ownership and responsibility for their work.

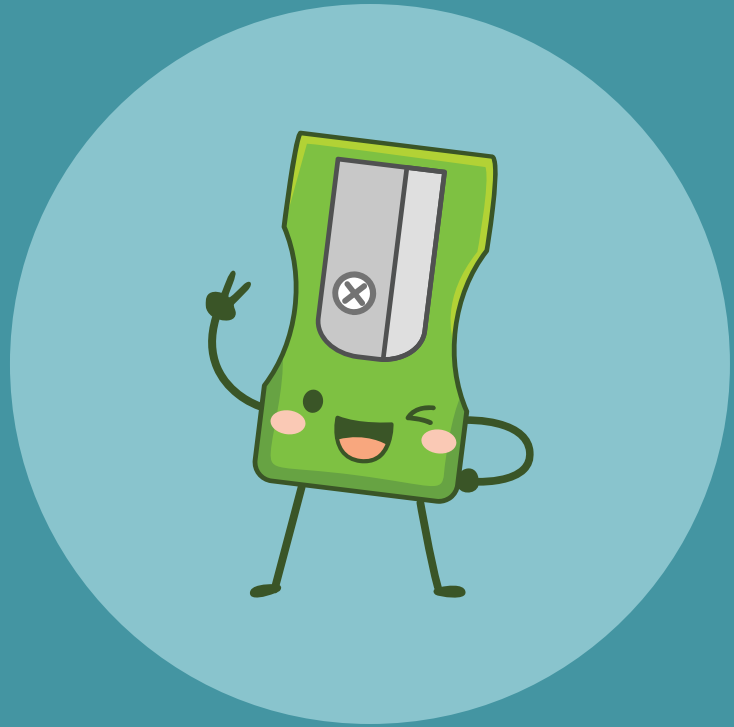
